



## *Code of Conduct*

### *Members/Participants and Visitors*

- The Club expects that all Members/Participants, Volunteers and Visitors ensure the safety and welfare of all Members/Participants, Spectators, Volunteers and Marshalls at all times during every Club Event.
- The Club, its Members/Participants, Volunteers and Visitors must, at all times, comply with all applicable Rules and regulations. (Refer to National Rules and Club Racing Rules)
- The Club will not condone the activities of Members/Participants who achieve results through violation of the Club Racing Rules, National Rules or unethical practices. This includes any payments for illegal acts, indirect contributions, rebates, and bribery. Penalties will be applied. (refer to Club Racing Rules)
- The Club expects its Members/Participants, Volunteers and Visitors to conduct themselves in a responsible manner. Drinking, fighting, swearing, and similar un-sportsmanlike behaviours are not tolerated.
- Respect the decisions of officials at all times.
- Smoking is not permitted in Pit area, Drivers Stand and Canteen area.
- Drugs and Alcohol will not be permitted, condoned or Tolerated at any time during Events.
- Any Race Result Protests are to be submitted during the event with the respective Race Steward. Refer to Club Racing Rules.
- Members/Participants, Volunteers and Visitors must not engage in sexual harassment, or conduct themselves in a way that could be construed as such, for example, by using inappropriate language, keeping or posting inappropriate materials in Social Media. (refer to Club Racing Rules) Positive participation in online Social Media is encouraged, Posting of derogatory and/or threatening material is not tolerated.
- All Members/Participants, Volunteers and Visitors share a serious responsibility for the Sports good public relations, especially at the community level. Their readiness to help with activities brings credit to the Club and is encouraged.
- Club funds and all other assets of the Club are purposed for the Club only and not for personal benefit. This includes the personal use of organizational assets, such as computers.
- Breaching the code of conduct or bringing the sport into disrepute online can lead to serious consequences including suspensions and cancellations of Membership All conduct standards are required by The Club Racing Rules and National Rules. Accordingly, Members/Participants and Visitors must ensure that their actions cannot be interpreted as being, in any way, in contravention of the Rules and Regulations governing the Club's operations or for the sport in general. Members/Participants or Visitors uncertain about the application or interpretation of any requirements should refer the matter to the Club President or an available Committee Member.
